

Notice of Night Work and Request for Cooperation

The following work will be conducted during night hours due to the ongoing construction of a new multi-story parking lot and an upper corridor at the Hakata Ward Office. The work will be carried out intermittently at night, with some traffic restrictions in place. Your cooperation would be appreciated as we proceed with utmost care.

- Work in progress: Construction of the new multi-story parking lot and an upper corridor at the Hakata Ward Office
- Night work is scheduled to be conducted from July 16, 2024 (Tuesday) to January 31, 2025 (Friday)
- Below are the details and periods of night work

Assembling the steel-frame of the parking lot: July 16 to late July

External works and dismantlement: Late August to early September

Piling work for the upper corridor: Mid-September to mid-October

Assembling the steel-frame of the upper corridor, scaffolding: Early November to late January, 2025

Concrete placing, dismantling of scaffolding, external works, etc.

△ Night work is not conducted on weekends (except between 12 midnight and 6 am on Saturdays)

△ The duration of night work may be subject to extension due to climate and other conditions.

You may hear noise due to the night work.

- Night work hours and traffic restrictions

Night work hours: 9 pm to 6 am

Traffic restrictions:

(Road) Closed to vehicles or implementing alternating traffic.

(Sidewalk) Closed to pedestrians on either both sides or one side of the street

△ Traffic guides are assigned when necessary. Your understanding and cooperation are appreciated.
